






ASF outbreaks distribution



Almost 5,000 pigs culled and death of ASF outbreak in 2019

- Legislation: Law on Animal Health and Production, MAFF declaration, Pro# 134 178 227 343, Directive#232 of MAFF, 30 May 2019 on the urgent measures to monitor and control and illegal imported pig and pig production
- **Collaboration:** MoH, MoI, MoJ, WOAH, FAO, Local authority and others
- **Control Measure:**
 - ✓ Disease outbreak investigation: sample collection, Identify the possible risk areas and factors
 - ✓ Disease outbreak response: Animal Movement Control, Culling, Disposal, Cleaning, public awareness
 - ✓ Disease Surveillance

- ✓ No compensation
- ✓ It is a new disease without vaccine
- ✓ Limitation of understanding of farmers in disease control
- ✓ Distribution of infect pig meat within outbreak area and other in the forms of fresh, dried and fermented
- ✓ High number of backyard farm in the country
- ✓ Limitation of government budgets to implements ASF control and response
- ✓ Staff capacity building especially on ASF control, prevention and response
- ✓ Strengthens the understanding of pig farms in disease control and biosecurity
- ✓ Improve knowledge on bio security practices in farm level, slaughterhouse and so on...
- ✓ Pilot ASF Compartmentalization, and education for all
