



COUNTRY REPORT "ASF Situation and its Prevention & Control"







Main challenges experienced by Malaysia involving:-

1) Sustainable funding - with increase of other emerging and re-emerging diseases + higher cost of lab testing requirements >> Malaysia requires financial aids to support the ASF control activities.

2) Safer Trade - enhancing the risk assessment and import protocols >> Malaysia requires collaborative and cooperative commitments from many Inter-agencies/Public Private Partnerships.

3) Technical issues - impromptu access to certain facilities or equipments (i.e. roro/special transport).

4) Politics - i.e. land issues (for disposal of carcasses).

5) Lack of awareness VS Attitudes (farmers, public, tourist) >> Malaysia has strengthening the awareness campaign.

6. Experties

Way forward to strengthen and improve capacities and capabilities through/in:

1) Governance & Legislation - policy, guideline protocols, etc.

2) Funding towards preparedness & control/prevention activities - more sustain

3) Early Detection/Early Warning Alarm System

4) Enhance knowledge and skills (training, sharing) - epidemiology, laboratory

5) Safer trades -- Food Security
