*ASF controlling programme was performed by three steps; preparedness, detection and response.

PREPAREDNESS

- Contingency Planning
- Legislation (Listed as Notifiable Disease)
- Awareness (Farm, Slaughter House, Transport)
- Surveillance
- International Collaboration (FAO, OIE)
- Simulation exercises
- Movement control (illegal)
- Strengthening border control for illegal pig products

DETECT

- Laboratory capacity building
- Biosecurity (Farm/Trader/Slaughter)
- Rapid Response Team (Communication/ Networking)

Awareness

RESPONSE

- Transparency (OIE reporting)
- ASF Review meeting s every years
- Directive order for restocking , pig movement, regulations for pig farms, owner/drivers of pig transporters, Rules for slaughter house and pig sellers/byers
- Rapid Pesponse Teams (RRT)
