



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 84

DECLARING MARCH AS THE RABIES AWARENESS MONTH,
RATIONALIZING THE CONTROL MEASURES FOR THE
PREVENTION AND ERADICATION OF RABIES AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, rabies is a dangerous disease of dog transmissible to humans through the bite of an infected animal;

WHEREAS, approximately 560,000 bite cases are reported every year;

WHEREAS, rabies accounts for the loss of approximately 300-400 Filipino lives every year and causes much agony and suffering to victims and their families before death;

WHEREAS, the disease can be prevented through mass immunization of pet dogs and responsible pet ownership;

WHEREAS, leashing of dogs and control of stray dogs are important complementary strategies in the control and eradication of rabies;

WHEREAS, information and education on rebies prevention measures, first aid for dog bites, and other relevant facts concerning rabies are critical for its eradication;

1.0 Background

- 1.1 Presidential Executive Order No. 84 dated March 13, 1999, declares the month of March of every year, as Rabies Awareness Month. In line with the objectives of Republic Act 9482 (The Anti-Rabies Act of 2017 of protecting and promoting people's right to health, this month celebration entails simultaneous mass rabies vaccination, spay and castration, poster-making contest, among other information drive campaign on responsible pet ownership.
- 1.2 Section 7 of the Act mandates the Local Government Units to enact an ordinance, to incorporate among others, programs on ensuring all dogs are vaccinated, establishment of dog pound, strict enforcement of dog impounding activities and control of stray dogs, prohibition of dog meat trade and regulation on the dog bite treatment, known as "tandok".

2.0 Purpose

2.1 This Memorandum Circular is issued to enjoin all DILG Regional and Field Offices, and local government units, to support the observance of the 2023 Rabies Awareness Month.

3.0 Scope/Coverage

 All Provincial, City, Municipal and Barangay Governments, DILG Regional and Field Offices, BARMM Ministry of the Interior and Local Government and all others concerned

4.0 Policy Content and Guidelines

- 4.1 All DILG Regional and Field Offices, provinces, cities, municipalities and barangays, in coordination with their respective Local Veterinary Offices and/or Municipal Agriculture Offices, in the case of lower income municipalities without veterinary offices, and Barangay Health Workers, are hereby enjoined to spearhead, participate and support anti-rabies campaign activities, such as, but not limited to the following:
 - 4.1.1 conduct of mass dog vaccination for the whole month of March, to the extent possible;
 - 4.1.2 mass dog and cat spay and castration, to the extent possible;
 - 4.1.3 display of streamer in front of the provincial/city/municipal/barangay hall, to carry the theme, "Rables-free na Pusa't Aso, Kaligtasan ng Pamilyang Pilipino", announcing LGU participation in said celebration; accessible at https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/1eEJ7YAb1ejewmY4IAxhwgACnRE3uag3V
 - 4.1.4 upload the official campaign streamer in LGU website, facebook and twitter accounts;
 - 4.1.5 disseminate rabies awareness information through networks and partners; and
 - 4.1.6 include rabies awareness advocacy in LGU related activities.

5.0 Effectivity

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
