• The Philippines by virtue of Republic Act (RA) 9482 otherwise known as the "Anti-Rabies Act of 2007" provided for and established a system for the control, prevention of the spread, and eventual eradication of human and animal Rabies and responsible pet ownership. The National Rabies Prevention and Control Committee (NRPCC), a multisectoral cooperation amongst different private and public agencies and offices mandated to oversee the implementation of the National Rabies Prevention and Control Program (NRPCP).
